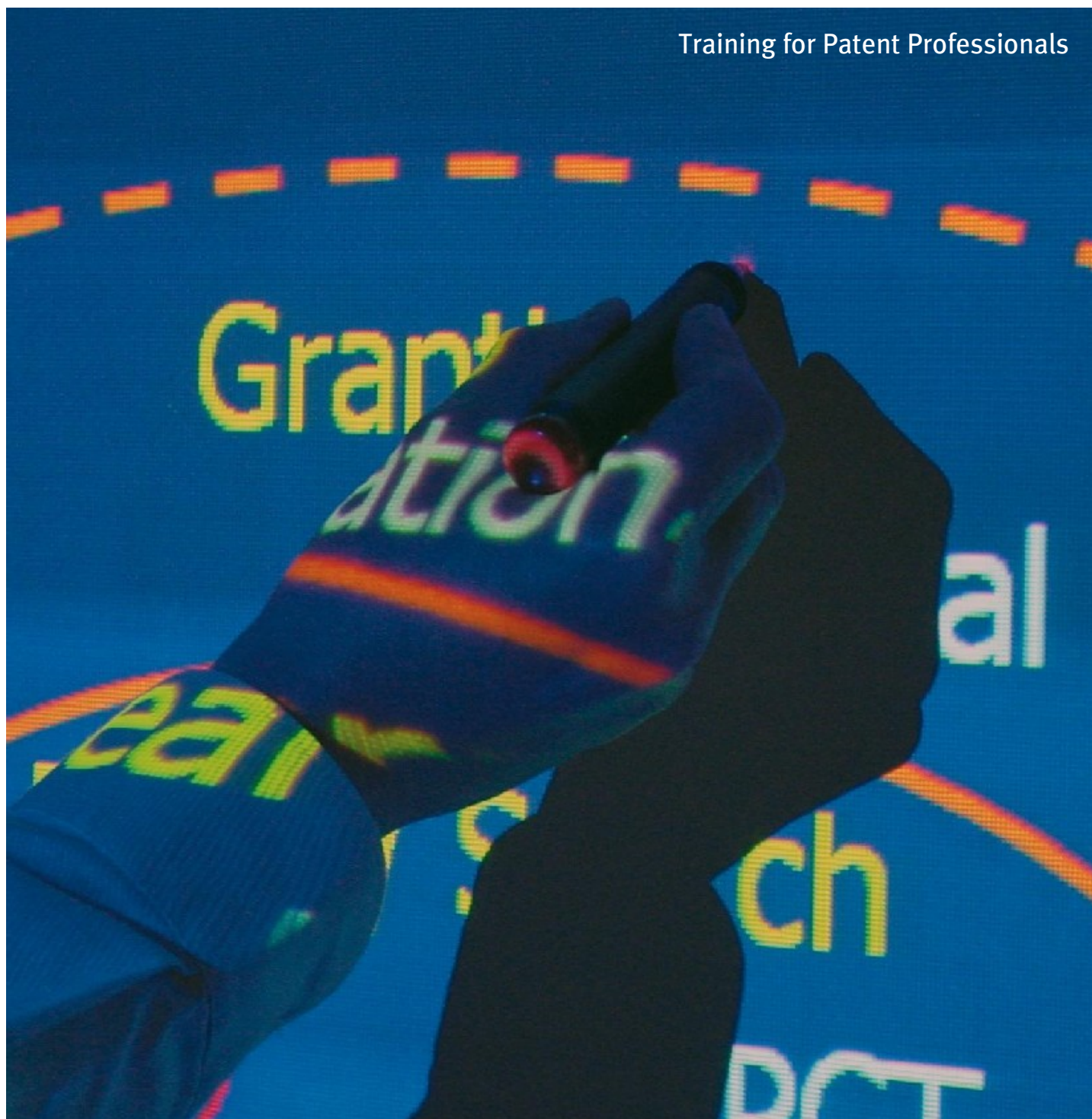

Advanced licensing course

ADVANCED LICENSING COURSE

Objective

In today's business world emphasis is increasingly put on cooperation and the use of technology developed and owned by others. Hence, technology transfer and licensing are becoming increasingly important to companies, research institutes and universities.

This course is tailored to professionals that have a basic understanding of licensing and who have some working experience in this field. It builds on the foundation provided by the Basic licensing course, and focuses in detail on a number of IP agreement provisions and schedules, as well as the definition and treatment of confidential technical information.

By the end of the course, participants will have gained advanced insight into various practical aspects of licensing agreements and processes in commercial environments. This course can be combined with the Basic licensing course into a two-day course.

Who should attend?

Patent professionals either from an industrial in-house IP department or from private practice, IP managers, and R&D and business managers that are involved in technology transfer and the exploitation of intellectual property rights.

Topics included

- Specification of confidential technical information
- Pre-contractual discussions
- Particular IP agreement provisions and schedules
- Basic design package/basic design and engineering package
- Managing a process licensing project
- Financing of an IP licensing project
- Information exchange meetings
- IP contamination
- Due diligence
- Patent litigation

Speaker

The course will be given by Jowi Burger.



- Jowi Burger is an experienced tutor. He is one of the few Certified Licensing Professionals in Europe. He worked for Shell where he gained during the past twenty years extensive knowledge of drafting and negotiation of IP agreements. Contract parties included other oil and petrochemical companies, technology licensors, engineering contractors, small and medium sized innovative companies, research organisations and universities.

Documentation

All participants will receive course material including all overhead sheets used during the course.

Course language

The material will be provided in English. Tuition will be in English (or Dutch if all participants agree).

Attendance limited to 20

This limitation will give participants the opportunity to thoroughly discuss all the issues covered by the course programme.

Certificate

A certificate of attendance will be given to each participant who attends the course.

Course location

The course will in principle be held in Eindhoven (NL). Please check www.deltapatents.com. In case of sufficient interest from a particular country the course may be held locally. The course can also be given on an in-house basis.
