Objective

The 2-day course aims to give candidates an insight into how to handle a paper B (answering a communication) of the European Qualifying Examination.

By the end of the course the candidates will have learnt how to analyse the prior art, client's letter, the application as filed and the communication to define novel, inventive and clear claims which provide the client with maximum protection. Candidates will be able to amend the claims, and to answer the communication.

Changes at the EQE 20171

Until the EQE 2016 for the B part a choice is given between Electricity-Mechanics and Chemistry. Starting at the EQE 2017 a single paper B will be examined, covering both technical fields.

Course Concept

An overview will be given of how Paper B has developed through the years.


For paper B we will explain how you are expected to deal with the proposal of the client and the in-depth argumentation required for arguing the basis for the amendment and inventive step using the problem-solution approach.

We will teach a methodology and show how to apply this methodology on new style papers and cases.



Highlights of the course

The methodology provides a workflow in which the documents are processed efficiently thereby leading to the intended solution of the paper.

The B 2017 exam paper will be used in this course.

 - Dealing with the client's letter and proposed claims
 - Finding the desired claims
 - Drafting the response to the EPO for paper B, focussing on arguing the basis for the amended claims and inventive step
 - Practicing mock exams and cases
 - Practice the B 2017 exam paper
